Commercial Drone Course

The 6-week commercial drone course to earn a Part 107 License includes 24 hours with an experienced drone instructor at Infinity Aero Club. In addition, students will learn how to build, service, fly and start a drone business. Concepts will cover all regulations and operational



skills to become fully-certified commercial drone pilots. Classes are self-paced and held on a rolling schedule individually or within group sessions.

Virtual Private Pilot

The "Virtual" Private Pilot Certificate is for youth who want to experience learning how to fly before age 16. Infinity Aero Club has a Gleim Aviation approved FAA certified Basic Advance Training Device (BATD) (https://www.gleimaviation.com/shop/cockpitbatd/) flight simulator in which students will do each lesson as if they are actually in the aircraft. Ground training as well as 26 instructor-led lessons are included.

Private Pilot Solo

The Private Pilot Solo course is ages 16 and older. Students get the Private Pilot ground school materials, 15 hours of flight time and, if they work hard enough, fly solo as their instructor watches from the ground. This is one of the most exciting times in any pilot's career.

Private Pilot's License

The full Private Pilot program is for kids 16 and older (16 is the minimum age to solo, 17 to get a license). Studying intensely and flying every day, this program can be completed during the summer. At minimum, 40 hours of flight time is required; however, total hours varies for each individual (60-70 hours is common.)



Aviation Maintenance Training Program

Our King School "Cleared For Aviation Maintenance" is a Part 147 compliant "On-the-Job Training Program" for ages 16 and up. This course offered by King Schools (https://kingschools.com/cleared-for-aviation-maintenance-edu) is self-paced and prepares students for the FAA A&P exam (18 years old). In addition to this course, you will need to work with one of our A&Ps to complete your On-the-Job Training (OJT). This course requires 68.5 hours of Online Knowledge Lessons and 531.4 hours of practical task elements.

Space Cadet Program

Astrophysics, space mission planning, modular rockets, aerospace engineering are all going to be introduced in this engaging summer program for teens and young adults.
